#### Introduction

This report provides an analysis of feedback from alumni on the academic performance and ambiance of the institution. The feedback was collected through a structured survey, comprising ten questions that allowed alumni to rate various aspects of their experiences.

#### Feedback Summary

- 1. Relevance of Degree to Present Job
  - o Excellent: 78.2%
  - o Very Good: 21.8%
  - o Good/Average/Poor: 0%

**Analysis:** The majority of alumni find their degree highly relevant to their current job, indicating strong alignment between academic programs and job market needs.

#### 2. Syllabus Design for Employability

- Excellent: 28.7%
- o Very Good: 59.8%
- o Good: 11.5%
- Average/Poor: 0%

**Analysis:** While the syllabus is generally seen as well-designed for employability, there is a small percentage of alumni who feel it could be improved further.

#### 3. Usefulness of Career Guidance and Mentoring

- o Excellent: 29.9%
- o Very Good: 43.7%
- o Good: 25.3%
- o Average: 1.1%
