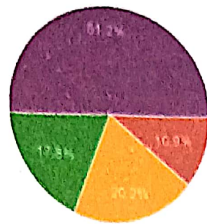

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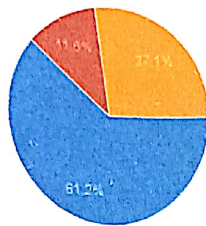

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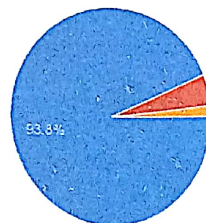

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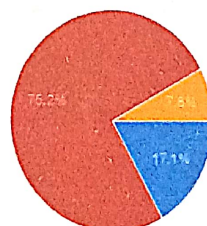

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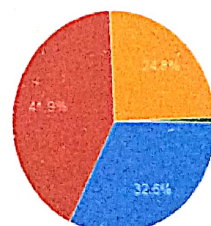

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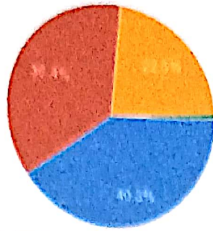

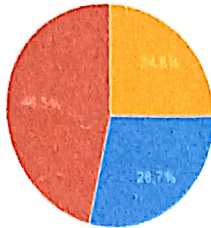

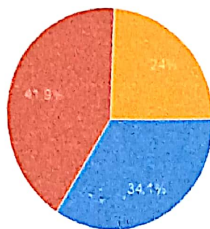

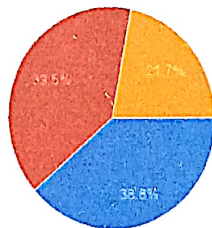

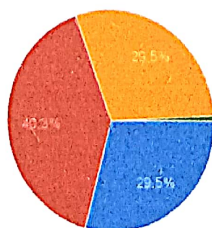

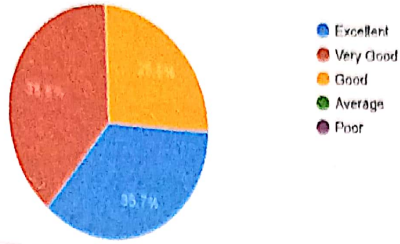

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How would you rate the communication and transparency of this institution's administration?

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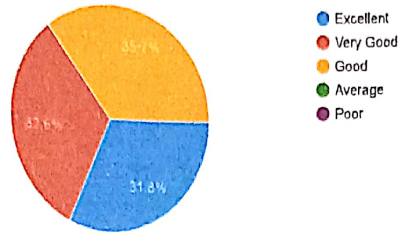

How well did this Institution align with your career goals and interests?


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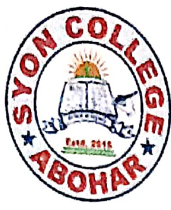

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Analysis Report of Alumni's Feedback on Academic Performance and Institutional Ambiance (2021-2022)

Introduction

This report presents an analysis of alumni feedback regarding their academic experiences and the overall ambiance of the institution. The feedback was collected through a structured survey with ten questions, allowing alumni to rate various aspects of their education and experience.

Feedback Summary

1. Relevance of Degree to Current Job


- **Excellent:** 93.8%
- **Very Good:** 4.7%
- **Good:** 1.5%
- **Average/Poor:** 0%

Analysis: A significant majority of alumni find their degrees highly relevant to their current job roles, indicating strong alignment between curriculum and industry needs.

2. Syllabus Design for Employability

- **Excellent:** 17.1%
- **Very Good:** 75.2%
- **Good:** 7.8%
- **Average/Poor:** 0%

Analysis: While most alumni rated the syllabus positively, only a small percentage deemed it excellent. This suggests room for improvement in tailoring courses to enhance employability.


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3. Career Guidance and Mentoring

- **Excellent:** 32.6%
- **Very Good:** 41.9%
- **Good:** 24.8%
- **Average/Poor:** 0.7%

Analysis: The responses indicate a generally positive perception of career guidance, though a notable portion still finds it lacking, highlighting potential areas for enhancement.

4. Overall Quality of Education

- **Excellent:** 40.3%
- **Very Good:** 36.4%
- **Good:** 22.5%
- **Average/Poor:** 0.8%

Analysis: The quality of education received is rated favorably, but there is a substantial portion of alumni who rated it only as 'Good,' indicating areas for growth.

5. Diversity and Inclusion Efforts

- **Excellent:** 27.7%
- **Very Good:** 46.5%
- **Good:** 24.8%
- **Average/Poor:** 0%

Analysis: While alumni appreciate diversity efforts, a large percentage still feel there is room for improvement in this area.

6. Sense of Community and Belonging

- **Excellent:** 34.1%
- **Very Good:** 41.9%
- **Good:** 24%


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- Average/Poor: 0%

Analysis: Alumni generally felt a sense of belonging, although there is potential to strengthen community engagement initiatives.

7. Fostering Critical Thinking and Problem-Solving Skills

- Excellent: 38.8%
- Very Good: 39.5%
- Good: 21.7%
- Average/Poor: 0%

Analysis: Most alumni recognize efforts to develop critical thinking skills, though improvements can be made in this area.

8. Clarity of Programme Outcomes

- Excellent: 29.5%
- Very Good: 40.3%
- Good: 29.5%
- Average/Poor: 0.7%

Analysis: The clarity of programme outcomes received mixed feedback, indicating a need for clearer communication of expected competencies.

9. Communication and Transparency of Administration

- Excellent: 35.7%
- Very Good: 38.8%
- Good: 25.6%
- Average/Poor: 0%

Analysis: Alumni perceive a generally transparent administration, though there is room for improvement in communication practices.

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10. Alignment with Career Goals and Interests

- o **Excellent:** 31.8%
- o **Very Good:** 32.6%
- o **Good:** 35.7%
- o **Average/Poor:** 0%

Analysis: Alumni feel moderately aligned with their career goals through their education, indicating opportunities for better alignment and support.

Conclusion

The feedback from alumni reveals strong overall satisfaction with their educational experience and its relevance to their careers. However, several areas for improvement have been identified, particularly in enhancing the employability-focused design of the syllabus, strengthening diversity and inclusion efforts, and improving career guidance.


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
