2. Balance of Theoretical and Practical Knowledge

- Strongly Agree: 21.1%
- o Agree: 78.9%
- o Undecided/Disagree/Strongly Disagree: 0%

- Undecided/Disagree/Strongly Disagree: 0%

4. Convenience of Semester Pattern

- Strongly Agree: 36.8%
- Agree: 55.3%
- Undecided: 7.9%
- Disagree/Strongly Disagree: 0%

8. Syllabus Design for Employability


Strongly Agree: 55.3%
